Flight of the Bumblebee Rimsky Korsakov Elizabeth & Donna

Nikolai Andreyevich Rimsky-Korsakov (1844-1908) was a Russian composer, and a member of the group of composers known as **The Five**. He was a master of **orchestration**. His best-known orchestral compositions—*Capriccio Espagnol*, the *Russian Easter Festival Overture*, and the symphonic suite *Scheherazade*—are staples of the classical music repertoire, along with suites and excerpts from some of his 15 operas. *Scheherazade* is an example of his frequent use of **fairy tale** and **folk subjects**. "**Flight of the Bumblebee**" is an orchestral **interlude** written by **Nikolai Rimsky-Korsakov** for his opera *The Tale of Tsar Saltan*, composed in 1899–1900. The piece closes Act III, Tableau 1, during which the magic Swan-Bird changes Prince Gvidon Saltanovich (the Tsar's son) into an insect so that he can fly away to visit his father (who does not know that he is alive). Although in the opera the Swan-Bird sings during the first part of the "Flight", her vocal line is **melodically** uninvolved and easily omitted; this feature, combined with the fact that the number decisively closes the scene, made easy extraction as an orchestral concerto piece possible

Scherzo Fantastique-Dance of the Goblins Op. 25 Antonio Bazzini 1818-1897 Elizabeth & Donna

Antonio Joseph Bazzini was an **Italian** violinist, composer and teacher. As a composer his most enduring work is his **chamber music** which has earned him a central place in the Italian instrumental renaissance of the 19th century. However his success as a composer was overshadowed by his reputation as one of the finest concert violinists of the 19th century. He also contributed to a portion of **Messa per Rossini**, specifically the first section of *II. Sequentia, Dies Irae*.
